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### List of essentials:

- A bag, whether a gift bag or a rucksack – something to put all of the items into.
- Toiletries – Shampoo, shower gel, soap, toothbrush and toothpaste, deodorant and sanitary or shaving items.
- Notepad and pen.
- Hat, gloves and scarf (2 of the 3 ideal)
